### The Pastor's Pen "Advent"

We are now in the season of Advent. Over 300 prophecies were actually fulfilled at the coming of the Christ Child. This is unlike the <u>National Enquirer</u> which makes its physic predictions in January only to reveal at the end of the year that just a certain percentage of the predictions had actually been fulfilled.

The Bible says that the Christ Child would come from the Tribe of Judah; that He would be born of a virgin; that He would be born in Bethlehem; that He would have a miraculous ministry; that He would suffer and die; but three days later, He would resurrect from the dead. Everything was fulfilled as the Bible said.

The Christ Child is not a figurine. He cannot be found in a crèche. He is the ascended Lord sitting at the right hand of Father God. To acknowledge Jesus as "Lord," means to turn full control over to Him.

The next time you pray and address Jesus as "Lord," here is the A, B, C of what you are really saying:

- You Affirm your allegiance to Him
- You Bow to His authority in all areas of your life
- You <u>Commit to Him all you are, have, and hope to be</u>

The Christmas season can be summed up in one word - INCARNATION. It means: "God became flesh." It is beyond human understanding that the Creator of the universe, who is infinite and eternal, condescended to be born of a virgin in an insignificant town called Bethlehem. How amazing!

- Though many have made Christmas a smorgasbord of commercialism, don't allow it to keep you from celebrating GOD DID BECOME FLESH!
- Remember that to experience Christmas, it is necessary to have Christmas (The Christ Child) in your heart, for you will never find it under a tree.
- Let the Season remind you that God is not distant, too busy, or engrossed with other challenges not to care for you; after all, GOD DID BECOME FLESH and has identified with all of us.
