#### **June Session Meeting Highlights**

**PNC** - PNC recommended that the Church Information Form, which prospective candidates for installed pastor respond to, be amended to show an effective salary of \$65,000. Recent information concerning the definition of effective salary helped clarify the uncertainty surrounding this term. As a result, the previously approved level of \$42,000 is insufficient to attract the type of candidate we are seeking. Session approved this recommendation. The issue of Presbytery support and assistance for our search was discussed.

**Sandpiper -** A sub-committee consisting of Laura Hannon, Tom Cornwell and David Harbaugh was established to develop a set of expectations concerning the Church's relationship with Sandpiper. Their work will be discussed at the next Session meeting.

**Vacation Bible School -** Thirty-four children attended VBS which ended June 14. Session expressed its appreciation for all the volunteers who made VBS possible this year.

**Jason Reese** - a former Congregation member, who gave the Church a \$10,000 unrestricted grant, filled the pulpit on June 23rd. Session hopes that you were able to attend one of these Services.

**Beach Services** - Kenny Easton will be conducting Services on the Beach several times this summer. Please be on the look-out for further information about these services.
