A WORD ABOUT FATHERHOOD

The "father image" is an important concept in scripture. Here are some things the Bible says to men:

- All Christian husbands are to love their wives "just as Christ loved the Church" (Ephesians 5:25).
- All Christian husbands are to be kind and understanding to their wives. If a man does not live this way with his wife he will experience "unanswered prayer" (1 Peter 3:7).
- Fathers are not to provoke their children to anger but to "bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4).
- Learn to communicate with your family.
- Express daily appreciation to the family but avoid flattery.
- Be an example in word, action and lifestyle. Do what you Say! Actions speak louder than words!
