#### **Session Highlights**

**April 10, 2012** 

**Congregational Survey** - a motion was made to establish a sub-committee consisting of Paul Rake, Karen Compton, Ruth Dyerly, Jayne Mann and Bruce Klimek to compile the information from the Surveys and prepare a preliminary report for the Session's consideration at a meeting scheduled for April 30 at 7 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall; seconded and passed.

**COM Pastoral Search Requirements** - Jim Yackel's e-mail reporting the tasks COM is requiring before a Pastor Nominating Committee can be established was discussed. It was concluded that a realistic time-line for fulfilling the requirements makes it clear that formation of a Pastor Nominating Committee is not imminent which is a matter of concern.

**April 22 Congregational Meeting on Bi-Laws** - Paul Rake and Tom Cornwell gave an overview of the issues related to updating the bi-laws and will provide a status report at the Congregational meeting. The relationship of the Church's three legal entities have to be addressed - the Church Corporation, the Endowment Fund and the Memorial Garden.

#### **Worship Services**

- Session praised the members of the Worship Committee for their efforts for the Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Services. The services were a true testament to God's glory.
- Session also expressed its appreciation to Rev. Smith for his contribution to Worship Services and the pastoral care he is providing. He will administer communion to shut-ins, nursing home residents and hospital patients at Session's direction.
- Session also expressed its gratitude for the leadership of Chuck Smothermon and Jacque Nagy for the Wednesday Lenten supper and prayer sessions. They were well attended (20+ per evening) and were powerful and meaningful sessions.
- A motion was made to approve the Summer Worship schedule from June 17 thru September 2 consisting of an 8:30 a.m. Garden Service and 10:00 a.m. inside service; the motion passed.


#### AN ELDER shares......
