October Session Meeting Highlights

October 8, 2013

Rev. Sewdin - The reports on Rev. Sewdin's recovery from heart by-pass surgery are encouraging. His current ETA at Ogden Dunes is mid-November. Session is going to follow-up to determine his status with his prior Congregation so that specific matters during this transition period can be addressed. While his health care costs are covered via the Presbyterian Pension and Health Care policy, the status of premium payments, living expenses, etc are not clear. The manse is being vacated by the current tenant and the delay in Rev. Sewdin's arrival allows more time to get it ready. Volunteers to do miscellaneous clean up, repair and painting are still needed.

Bi-Laws - A review of a draft of bi-laws which have been revised by the trustees has been delayed due to the matters relating to the call of Rev. Sewdin. As this review resumed, it became clear that the work and background leading to the revisions needed to be refreshed. In addition to the Church, there are three separate legal entities associated with it - the Church Corporation, the Endowment Fund and the Memorial Garden. The bi-laws at issue relate to the way the Church elects its trustees and officers, holds meetings and deals with property. The existing bi-laws are antiquated. The trustees will revisit their work and resubmit it to the session for approval. Once the session approves the revisions the congregation will have to vote to approve them. Matters relating to the Endowment Fund and Memorial Garden are unaffected by the bi-laws under current review, but their governing documents also need to be scheduled for review and needed revision.

Consecration Sunday - A pot-luck dinner is planned after the November 3rd Worship Service. Letters and minutes for missions leading up to it are underway.

"....An Elder shares..."

When you read Moby Dick you become struck by the un-relenting anger of Ahab. He expresses more than just revenge at the brute force of nature, he expresses a desire to destroy the perceived absurdity it represents. It is as if he is plagued with a misunderstanding of life, coming eventually to strike at the whale with vehement 'hate for hate's sake.' His first mate, Starbuck being a Christian man of faith, recognizes it all, and yet cannot commit the necessary murder of his captain to save the ship.

Melville experienced the Great Awakening of his time and in the end his book gives us a study in motivations. To be sure, we all confront limitations in perceiving the real motivations of others. Limited by a "common language which divides us", we can foment significant injustice in acting upon our incorrect suppositions. Should we not be careful in what we presume as an ill will from a fellow traveler's mistaken word or deed. Indeed, saving the ship sometimes requires a sacrifice we do not readily see. But when it is our time, let us reflect upon righteousness as a guide to our actions and love as a guide to our beliefs.
