From The Pastor's Pen "How Can I Know There Is A God?"

Ever so often I am asked the question: "What about the fate of the people who have died and have never heard the Gospel of Jesus Christ?" Though it is a difficult question, nevertheless, the Bible does provide an answer.

Psalm 19 contemplates the beauty of the heavens including the stars, sun and moon. These are not there for mere aesthetics. They serve a larger purpose. "The heavens declare the glory of God and the skies proclaim the work of His hand" (v.1). The beauty of Nature and Creation is to reveal that behind it, there is a Master Mind, an Architect who created it all. The Bible reveals Him as God Almighty. So, Creation serves as an invitation to those who have never heard the Gospel to acknowledge God's existence.

The Apostle Paul writing 1,000 years later, affirms what the Psalmist wrote in Psalm 19. He said: "Since the creation of the world, God's invisible attributes, eternal powers and divine nature, have been already seen...by what He has made, so that EVERYONE IS WITHOUT EXCUSE" (Romans 1:20).

Therefore, the splendor of the sky is not a mere distraction or cosmic accident; rather, it is the intentional work of a Creator God. As such, Nature reveals a God of might, intelligence and One who creates everything with intricate details. A God of order and beauty.

But there is still another witness to God's Existence. The Scripture tells us in Romans chapter 2, verses 14-16, that God has placed within every human being "The Voice of Conscience." Missionaries have discovered that in every culture, there was always evidence of a Moral Law. Where did it come from? Of course, God! What is it? The Conscience! God has placed within every heart the ability to discern right from wrong. His justice will be meted out to everyone based on two criteria — The Book of Nature and the Voice of Conscience.

So, think about it! Everyone is without excuse! This God, whom You may not believe in, does love you. He has revealed His love through the spectacular beauty of Creation, the Wonders of Nature and the still, small voice called Conscience. Above it all, He sent His Son to die on the cross so that everyone can experience forgiveness of sins and the gift of eternal life! Even if you do not believe in Him, He does love you!

- Muslim Indonesia has issued a ban on the teachings of the <u>Islamic State</u> formerly known as ISIS.
 Indonesia which has the largest Muslim adherence says that "the ISIS teachings are not a religious issue; rather, it is a group promoting an extreme version of Wahhabi Islam, a radical movement believing in the fundamentalist ideals of the religion." (ENS)
- A coalition of more than 50 religious leaders, led by mostly conservative Catholics, Evangelical and Jewish activists, has called on president Obama to sharply escalate military action against Islamic extremists in Iraq. They say "nothing short of the destruction" of the Islamic State can protect Christians and religious minorities now being subjected to "a campaign of genocide." (RNS)
- Speaking at St. Peter's Square, Pope Francis said: "The news coming from Iraq leaves us
 incredulous and appalled. All this seriously offends God and seriously offends humanity. You cannot
 bring hatred in the name of God. You cannot make war in the name of God." (RNS)
