August 13, 2013

PNC - PNC presented information on Rev. Sewdin to whom they presented a call and who accepted. A request for a congregational meeting to approve this call was made and by motion Session approved a congregational meeting after the second service on August 25th. Reverend Sewdin will preach at both services prior to this congregational meeting. PNC presented a financial package associated with the call. At a follow-up meeting, Session engaged in a detailed discussion of the total impact of the package and prayed about the decision to be made. Then the financial package was approved unanimously.

WELCOME REV. SEWDIN

Reverend Dr. Lloyd Sewdin has a Master of Divinity degree from Conwell Theological Seminary, a Master of Theology degree from Princeton Theological Seminary and a Doctor of Ministry degree from Pittsburgh Theological Seminary. He has been a Presbyterian pastor over the last 20 years and before that was a guest speaker for numerous denominations and organizations around the world.

Dr. Sewdin demonstrates a true heart for God and calling to the ministry, exuding energy of spirit and witness. In his sermons and interactions with his congregation, Dr. Sewdin relates God's word to everyday living through his in-depth grasp, understanding and recall of the scriptures. He evangelizes to congregants individually emphasizing each one's unique value by promoting a positive Christian value for their lives. His goal is to encourage and empower others in becoming disciples in doing God's work.

Dr. Sewdin's goals for God's church are to welcome all and to achieve a loving and sustaining environment where interest is openly shown for the welfare, growth and comfort of all and where openness to new ideas is encouraged. He seeks to promote a worshipping church that is open to the spiritual needs of those with a traditional background as well as those who desire a more contemporary form of worship.

Dr. Sewdin views breakdown of the family and marriage as among **the key issues facing the church today**. The wide generation gap is another with the task of the church to bring them together.

In his "statement of faith", Dr. Sewdin affirms 1) that the Bible is the infallible word of God - the final authority for our faith and practice, 2) that God is an infinite, eternal spirit – unchanging in his wisdom, power, holiness, justice and truth and that He manifests Himself in three distinct persons ... Father, Son and Holy Spirit ... each of whom is the Godhead and 3) that humanity's sins were atoned for by Jesus' death and resurrection, providing reconciliation with God through faith in Christ. 4) The Holy Spirit gives life, energy, and movement to all creation. The Holy Spirit works with the unbeliever through "prevenient grace". Continuing about the Holy Spirit, Dr. Sewdin speaks of "pre-conversion state", effectual grace", "actual grace", and habitual grace". 5) "The church is God's covenant community of believers who are active participants..."

Dr. Sewdin's **leadership style** is that of a "servant –leader". He believes Christ alone is the head of the church.

Dr. Sewdin's wife, Barbara, is a caring, compassionate and deeply spiritual individual who actively supports and contributes greatly to Lloyd's ministry. She is a gifted singer. Barbara looks forward to adopting our church as her family.
