The Pastor's Pen

The palm leaves...the singing...the shouting...It was a celebration in faith. The VICTORY was still to come. Jesus allowed the people to celebrate a triumph in faith—a triumph they had never seen. But the events of Good Friday were shattering. It seemed so final. Try to imagine the moment. Fear immobilized faith. Grief eclipsed the victories of the years with Christ. All seems lost. Hopelessness and helplessness prevailed.

Then Easter Sunday came. It was the day God circled on His calendar for a breakthrough. A breakout. A resurrection. Not just for His Son but for all of us. That is why Apostle Paul; writes: "Thanks be to God who <u>always</u> causes us to triumph!" (2 <u>Corinthians</u> 2:14).

Notice that this triumph is not an "occasional triumph" or a "once-in-a-while" triumph. You are called to <u>always</u> triumph in Christ Jesus. Because of the all-surpassing goodness of your heavenly Father, you will <u>always</u> defeat whatever "enemy" you face.

You have the victory...even before you see the victory. That's what Easter is all about. God did something so big...so bold...so out-of-the box that your whole life will be revolutionized by it. Every pain you feel, God can heal. Every dream that has died, God can resurrect. You will no longer be defined by the crucifixion of yesterday but by the resurrection of tomorrow.

The prophet Hosea said it best: "He has torn us to pieces but He will heal us...After two days He will revive us. On the <u>third day</u> He will restore us..." (6:1,2) We are PEOPLE of the THIRD DAY!

During Jesus' earthly life, colored cloth was very expensive. Only royalty and wealthy people could afford it. When Jesus was arrested and sentenced to die, the soldiers set about humiliating him (see <u>Mark</u> 15:16-20, NRSV). They found a purple cloak—the color of royalty—and put it on him. Then they placed a crown of thorns on Jesus' head. "Hail, King of the Jews!" they mockingly cried. The soldiers hit Jesus with a reed and spat on him. They taunted him and knelt before him, pretending to honor him. Despite what he endured, our Lord did end up a King—King of kings and Lord of lords.
