The Pastor's Pen "Facing Life's Curveballs"

Has life thrown you a curve ball? Has life thrown you down and there is no one there to help you? You are not alone!

There was a woman who was caught in adultery. The religious people brought her to Jesus. The Religious Law stated that she should be stoned to death. They asked Jesus what should be her punishment. Jesus was in a dilemma. If He said: "Don't stone her," He would be guilty of violating the Law. If He said: "Stone her," then that would contradict why He came to earth ("to seek and save those who are lost.")

Meanwhile, the woman was lying on the ground waiting to die. She was waiting to feel that first rock hit her body. Her anxiety was as bad as the rock. She knew it was all over for her. She was guilty. There was no way out.

All of a sudden, she heard a rock fall and another and another but none hit her. Everyone of her accusers left. Her trouble was over but she was still lying on dirt. Then Jesus made her realize that she had passed from one season (the season of sin) to another season (the season of forgiveness). He told her that He didn't condemn her and that she could return home and quit sinning.

What Lessons can we glean from this story for ourselves:

- The Grace of God is greater than all of our sins.
- We can be forgiven instantly and fully.
- It's not the destination that's important; rather, it's the Interruptions God sends into our lives to bring us back to Him that's important.
- God has a right to condemn us but He doesn't because through Christ we are declared cleansed, free, delivered and children of God.

Life may have labeled you a loser, a failure or hopeless.. You may have made mistakes and decisions that have caused you to be in the dirt of life. But you don't have to continue living there. God can make you a winner and an overcomer if you commit your life to Him.

God may have given you a second chance at life or He wants to give you a second chance. Don't waste it. Don't take it for granted. He saved your life for a purpose—His purpose! This may be your last chance




### **PRIMETIMERS NEWS**
