Barbara Byrd Sewdin, soprano and David Tang, tenor will present a short afternoon concert entitled, "An Enchanted Afternoon of Music." The Primetimers organization of Ogden Dunes will feature the concert in their June 16th meeting at the Ogden Dunes Community Church...

Musical selections will include "Somewhere," from "West Side Story," "If Ever I Would Leave You" from Camelot, and the beautiful classic Italian love song, "Caro, Mio Ben."

Barbara is a former member of The St. Louis Symphony Chorus. She won the "National Teachers of Singing" regional competition held at Washington University. Barbara has traveled extensively in the U.S. and abroad as a guest artist. She has appeared as a guest artist on Christian television and radio. She was selected by the McKeesport Pa. Music Club to be their representative in concert with the Music Clubs of Pittsburgh. Barbara was the guest soloist for the opening ceremonies of "The Regatta Festivals" of Augusta Ky., "The Bracken County Fairs", "The Veterans Association of Northern Kentucky 25 Year Celebration." She also traveled throughout the Pittsburgh and Philadelphia Pa. areas and the state of New York performing in productions which she penned on "Women of the Bible."

David Tang with his beautiful tenor voice has thrilled audiences over the years with his wonderful gift of song as he performed in various groups and organizations throughout the area. Barbara and David are present members of the Ogden Dunes Community Church Choir, under the direction of Libby Larson, music director.

Accompanying them will be the gifted musician, **Jean Bell**. Jean has accompanied soloists, choruses, including The Metropolitan Opera Regional Auditions, and the Contemporary soloists competitions at the 92nd Street YMCA in NYC. She also served as music director and organist at churches in Chicago, IL and Tulsa, OK. Her organ tours of Europe include the Bach Organs in Germany and the Caveille-Coll organs in France. She was music director for ten seasons at the UW summer "Theater on the Bay" and the winter opera theater. While teaching piano at Tulsa Junior College, she served as Fine Arts Coordinator for Holland Hall Episcopal Prep School and the Tulsa Philharmonic Chorus. At present she serves as accompanist for Ogden Dunes Community Church.

The Pastor's Pen

Instead of my usual article, I want to share with you an article I recently read from <u>Christianity Today</u> entitled "Christian forgiveness of ISIS."

More than 1 million people watched on Arabic television as 10-year old Myriam, an Iraqi Christian forced to flee Mosul, Iraq, as ISIS advanced last year, forgave her persecutors. "I will only ask God to forgive them. Why should they be killed?" she told SAT-7 in its most watched interview ever. The Christian broadcaster also hosted Bashir Estephanos, the brother of 2 of the 21 Christians beheaded in Libya, who prayed for the killers on air. "[Their] calls are a form of resistance-through forgiveness," said Farid Samir, SAT-7's Egypt director. The statement drew praise from the region's secular Arabic press and the dean of Islamic studies at Cairo's al-Azhar University later read Matthew 5's "love your enemies" at a seminar.

Here's a personal note. There is absolutely no way any human being can demonstrate such forgiveness under such circumstances. This speaks of the Power of Jesus Christ within the heart of the believer to forgive unconditionally. Try Jesus! He will give you that same power <u>if</u> you really want to forgive. NO EXCUSES!
