## Pastor's Weekly Devotional- January 19, 2017 "Stand Up For Jesus"

Oftentimes, the scripture compares this life to a battle. The Christian as a soldier warning against the foe. The well-beloved hymn of the last century "Stand Up For Jesus" reflects this theme. It was inspired by the dying words of a young pastor, Dudley Tyng, who was fatally injured in a tragic accident.

Stand up, stand up for Jesus, Ye soldiers of the Cross. Lift high his royal banner, it must not suffer loss.

It the Old Testament, the soldier needed physical armor and weapons – but even more important, he needed the covenant protection of God. Today, the New Testament Christian soldier must fight, but not in a physical sense. Instead, the Christian is involved in spiritual warfare (See <u>Ephesians</u> 6:12). We are promised safety and victories if we "put on the whole armor of God."

The source of our Salvation and Victory is the same. Our "Gospel Armor" includes "Truth...Righteousness...Peace...Faith...Salvation...and the Word of God" (<u>Ephesians</u> 6:14-17). We put on our armor for daily protection through the avenue of prayer – "Having done all – STAND!" Stand up for Jesus!
