Easter is now behind us as an event. However, "the Easter experience" continues. It is a personal experience with the living Lord. It will continue until God calls us "home."

Peter boasted of his love for Christ and declared that if everyone forsook Christ, it wouldn't be him. But his love faded as he denied Christ three times. But that's not the end of the story.

The resurrected Lord came looking for Peter. In His post-resurrection appearance, He sent a message to Peter. "Tell Peter...I will see him." Later on, in another post-resurrection appearance, Jesus built a fire and prepared breakfast for some of the disciples who had gone fishing – among them was Peter. It was around the fireplace where Jesus reached out to Peter and asked him if he loved Him (Jesus). Peter denied Jesus three times so Jesus reached out to Peter three times in order to restore him.
